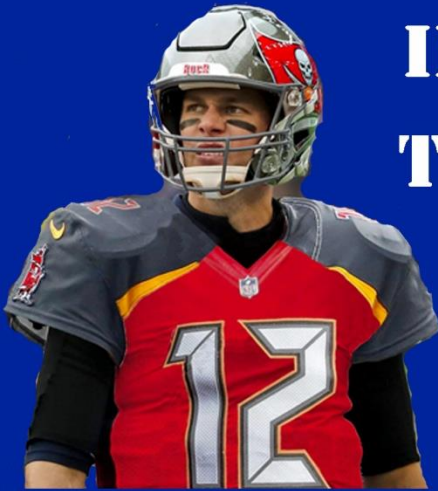

PSa 7-10-20	An owner asked a question about players who get the virus and would be out for two weeks or more. What will happen to the player, roster wise. Also practice squads for NFL teams will be going from 10 to 12 - 16 players. We know players will get the virus. What will we do with our rosters. What has been proposed is allow the players to be moved to the practice squad until they are returned to the roster when healthy. The same applies, that you have 1 week to move the player back to the roster, when NFL teams make the move, and make a player cut to keep the roster at 20. After 1 week the player will be waived by the league and moved to the free agent pool. Now PS can only be PUP, suspended and 1 rookie. This rule change will only be for 2020 season and if passed reviewed at the banquet if it's still needed. To and from PS and players added to replace or waive will not count towards the transaction totals. This rule is for 2020 season only and be reviewed at the 2020 banquet for the 2021 season. PSb 8-19-20	Payouts for 2020 season. If the NFL does not play a full season, payouts will be adjusted to the amounts of league weeks played. The season needs to be a 7 week season for the FFL89 to be official. If it is a full season payouts will be paid as per league rules. For the season each regular season week will count as 1/13 for the divisions and wildcards. Payouts for the weekly high's, most PF will also be paid. If no playoffs, Super Bowl and remaining weekly highs will be totaled and divided by 1/12. Money remaining from the keeper money will be carried over to the next season. The banquet money if not used will not be paid the following season as it will be carried over. With the money a team wins can either be paid out or carried over to the 2021 season. Also additional money not used will be added up and divided by 1/12. Each team will make arrangements with Tony on what they want to do. Examples of a 7 week season: Division - 175.00, Wild Card - 121.00 plus 7 weekly highs and most PF (8 payouts). Additional weeks would raise the total payout. Our current tie breakers will be used. Draft order will be used for the next season only if 7 plus weeks are played and last and eleventh place teams will get the first two picks of the rookie draft. 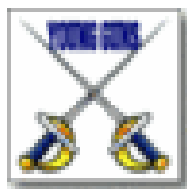
The three gold stars represent the three owners who have been in the league since 1989.

In 1989 the league was a total points scored league. In 1990 the league changed to head to head style league. Since 1990 all team names have changed, some more than others. But, one team name has stayed the same since 1990. Young Guns. They have changed logos three times.



1990 – 1992 divisions changed by drawing divisions from the hat for the following season. Then in 1993 – 2010 divisions remained the same, East, West and Central. In 2011 the league went to four divisions, North, South, East and West. From 1990 – 2010 only one team never changed divisions, luck of the draw. Strange Brew was always in the East.

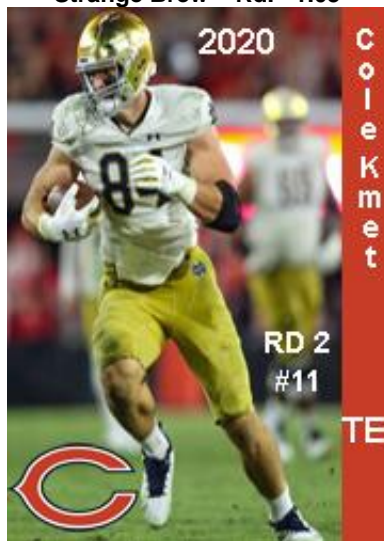

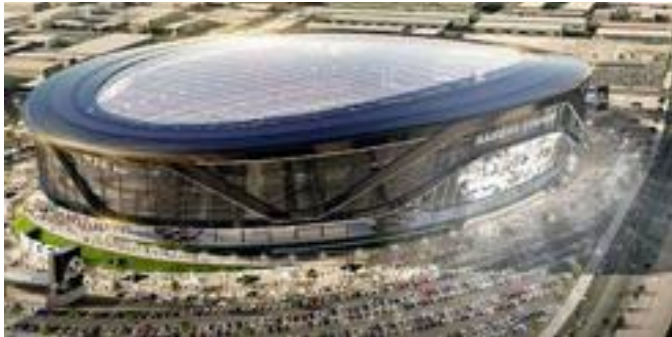

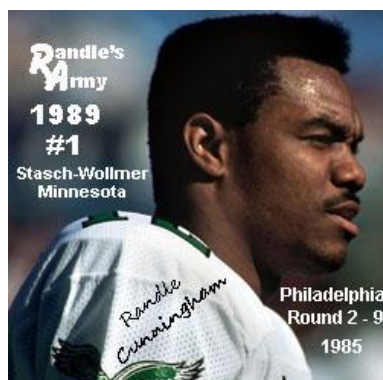
